If you want to present your research, please submit a (working) title, brief outline (50-100 words) and the type of contribution (e.g., presentation, talk, demonstration, interactive format, mini workshop etc.) by **30<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER**. All contributions must fit into a 30 min time slot including feedback and discussion.
